Background: IKKα (IκB Kinase alpha subunit) – The IκB Kinase (IKK) complex is the key enzyme involved in the activation and translocation of NFκB (NFκB p50 & NFκB p65). The IKK complex is composed of two catalytic subunits (IKK α and IKK β) and a regulatory subunit (IKK γ).

NF κ B signaling is negatively regulated by the sequestration of the NF κ B complex in the cytoplasm by its association with the I κ B family of inhibitory proteins. Upon its activation, the IKK complex phosphorylates I κ B α at Ser32 and Ser36. This results ultimately in the degradation of I κ B and the activation and nuclear translocation of NF κ B. While both IKK-alpha and IKK-beta subunits are Ser/Thr kinases, IKK-beta appears to be the principal kinase, as IKK α is not required for activation of the IKK complex and the subsequent degradation of I κ B α .

Immunogen: This IKK α antibody was raised against a full-length protein corresponding to human IKK α .

Buffer: PBS containing 0.02% sodium azide. Sodium azide is highly toxic.


Applications Validated by Active Motif:

WB: 1 - 2 μg/ml dilution

For optimal results, primary antibody incubations should be performed at room temperature. The addition of 0.1% Tween 20 to all blocking solutions may also reduce background. Individual optimization may be required.

Storage and Guarantee: Some products may be shipped at room temperature. This will not affect their stability or performance. Store at 4°C for short term. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles by aliquoting items into single-use fractions for storage at -20°C for up to 2 years. Keep all reagents on ice when not in storage. IKK α detection by Western blot analysis. The detection of IKK α was performed using 30 μ g of whole-cell extract from Daudi cells with the IKK α mAb at a 1 μ g/ml dilution.
